Each Division comprises 5 Joint Brigades, 2 Active, 1 Reserve/National Guard, 2 Paper.


Each Brigade comprises 5 Joint Regiments, 2 Active, 1 Reserve/National Guard, 2 Paper.

Each Regiment comprises 5 Joint Battalions, 2 Active, 1 Reserve/National Guard, 2 Paper.

Each Battalion comprises 5 Joint Companies, 2 Active, 1 Reserve/National Guard, 2 Paper.

Each Company comprises 5 Joint Platoons, 2 Active, 1 Reserve/National Guard, 2 Paper.

Each Platoon comprises 5 Joint Squads, 2 Active, 1 Reserve/National Guard, 2 Paper.

Engineering, and Assault
force. Air Force provides
Fires, Sustainment,
Engineering, and Intelligence
force. And so forth.

The US Joint Army must be an integrated Joint Force because the very components of force distribute across the human-built formations who are summoned to use them.

Generals and Admirals are the light-giving sun and stars.

The General Staff are the Arborist.

Battle Groups are formed from Divisions or Corps.

Armies are formed from Corps.

Army Groups are formed from Armies.
